




Distribution of Graduates with Teaching Qualification by Department (2023)




Library Lending Distribution (2024)






2024 Library Lending Data

Boğaziçi University Library, which started its international ILL service in 1993 by only bringing books from libraries abroad, has added sending books since 2008 and has become an important resource for academic institutions in Turkey and abroad.



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2024 Library Electronic Database Subscriptions

Boğaziçi University Library offers a wide range of digital and electronic resources, providing access to a wealth of information for students, academics and researchers. The Archives and Documentation Centre digitises special collections donated or acquired by the university, preserves them in accordance with international standards and makes them open access. In addition, the library subscribes to 57,274 e-journals and these resources can be easily accessed through the BrowZine application. The library also expands its information and learning opportunities with online training and seminars.

The library offers a total of 125 databases to its users, including full-text e-journals, e-books, music/video databases, reference databases, standards, statistics and data services, and legal databases. These digital resources are critical to education, research and professional endeavours and form the basis of the library's services to its users.

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Public Events (Lifelong Education)

BU+ is a dynamic organisation born out of the intellectual vitality of Boğaziçi University. Cultural and artistic activities have played a major role in our university's long-standing existence as a unique and valuable institution. Boğaziçi University, which has a rich culture and arts tradition through clubs, magazines and centres, has recently aimed to invite the 'outside' to the 'inside' and to spread the synergy arising from this merger to all campuses. While opening the doors of our university to the 'outside', it has also been ensured that this relationship is two-way. With the Open Lecture programme, it is aimed to present current science courses prepared by academics at our university to the public through joint projects with various municipalities.



Boğaziçi Chronicles: Boğaziçi University's international residency programme 'Boğaziçi Chronicles' was launched in 2013 with the aim of contributing to the cultural life of Istanbul and has become a tradition at our university as a rare residency programme in Turkey. Within the framework of the programme, world-renowned theorists and artists stay on campus and organise various talks, seminars, performances and workshops.



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"**Boğaziçi Chronicles**" guests become a part of university life by coming together with students, academics and Istanbulites. They transform their creativity and intellectual accumulation into new productions in the vibrant cultural atmosphere of Istanbul and keep a diary of their experiences. These diaries are published by Boğaziçi University and shared with a wide audience.



Boğaziçi University Lifelong Education Centre (BÜYEM) offers a wide range of educational programmes to meet the educational needs of individuals, institutions and society, using Boğaziçi University's academic background and innovative educational approach. Below are the main categories of education programmes offered by BÜYEM:

1. Specialisation Programmes are specialisation programmes in basic and interdisciplinary fields for university graduates: Institutionalisation in Family Businesses, Digital Marketing and Social Media, Train-the-Trainer Industry 4.0, Human Resources, Construction Project Management, Corporate Sustainability, Mechatronics, Supply Chain Management, Applied Financial Management, Visionary Marketing, Store and Product Management in Retail Sector

2. Executive Programmes are professional development focused programmes for executives in the areas of leadership, creativity, innovation and management: Design Thinking, Corporate Sustainability, Business Leadership Academy (LAB), Executive Training Abroad, Board Membership Training, Executive Leadership, Professional Development Seminars, Sustainable Development Goals Academy (SDG Academy)

3. Vocational Training Programmes are designed for people with at least high school graduates who want to learn a new profession or who have not had the opportunity to study at university: Banking, Event Management, Property Consultancy, Public Relations, Hotel Management, Marketing, Travel Agency, Web Application Design and Development, Software Development

4. Skill Acquisition Programmes are skill acquisition programmes for both high school and university graduates: Digital Transformation, Digital Marketing Communication, GMAT Preparation, Project Development, TOEFL Preparation, Foreign Language Trainings (English, German, French, Spanish, Russian, Arabic, Chinese, Japanese, Ottoman, Italian)

5. Update Programmes and Short Courses are programmes organised for university graduates to update their knowledge in a specific field. 5 Weeks 5 Novels, BOUN 101: Winter and Summer Schools, Autumn and Spring Workshops, Philosophy for Children, Financial Mathematics, Money, Foreign Exchange and Capital Markets, Sustainable Brand Management, Applied Entrepreneurship

6. e-BÜYEM Trainings are interactive trainings offered online through the e-BÜYEM platform: Online English, Online Innovation and Entrepreneurship, Turkey's Energy Academy, Human Resources, Innovative Management and Engineering

7. Second Spring Academy, specially designed programmes with the support of the Harvard Institute for Learning in Retirement (HILR) for those who want to return to university life, offer lifelong learning opportunities in a campus environment with the distinguished instructors of Boğaziçi University: Turkey and World Perspectives, Social Sciences, Fine Arts and Literature, History and Archaeology

8. Teacher Academy is specialised training for K12 teachers to develop their 21st century teaching skills. The trainings can be designed as short-term seminars, workshops or modules lasting over a year. In addition, new methods developed within the scope of EU projects are adapted to the Turkish education system and used in these trainings.

9. Corporate Services are the training programmes, corporate consultancy services and examination centre services that BÜYEM provides for private, public and non-governmental organisations.

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Social Aid Activities for Education Off-Campus

Boğaziçi University KRDAE Disaster Preparedness Laboratory



The Disaster Preparedness Laboratory (AHLAB) at Boğaziçi University Kandilli Observatory and Earthquake Research Institute dates back to the Disaster Preparedness Education Project (AHEP) initiated after the 1999 Kocaeli Earthquake and funded by the United States Agency for International Development (USAID/OFDA). The project aims to reduce the loss of life and property against a possible earthquake and to increase the disaster awareness, local preparedness and first response organisation skills of the public. In this context, four main training programmes, handbooks, CDs and information cards were developed. The programmes are delivered to different segments of the society within the framework of protocols signed with the Ministry of National Education, Ministry of Interior General Directorate of Civil Defence, Ministry of Health, Turkish Red Crescent Society/American Red Cross, local administrations and various NGOs.

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Training on Mitigation of Non-Structural Hazards (YOTA):



Earthquakepark Applications

Children, young people and employees coming to AHLAB for Basic Disaster Awareness Training from various schools and institutions are shown how faulting occurs during earthquakes and the difference between an earthquake safe building and a defectively constructed building with the models in the Earthquake Park after the class; an earthquake simulation is made in the classroom and children's room set up on the 'Shaking Table' and behavioural practices during the shaking are performed; and search and rescue activities after the earthquake are animated with models in the 'Post-Earthquake Corner'.

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

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In 2023, Corporate Trainings Provided on Earthquake and Disaster Awareness



Boğaziçi University Kandilli Observatory and Earthquake Research Institute organised comprehensive corporate trainings for companies from various sectors in 2024, reaching a total of 8404 participants. The trainings, which were organised in cities such as Istanbul, Izmir, Kocaeli and Gebze, were mainly given under the GEDSET and ABCD titles. Large companies such as BAT, Qnb Finansbank, Oyak Pazarlama, Egger Dekor and Borusan participated in these trainings, which contributed to the professional development of employees. The trainings were organised for both small groups and large groups of participants and were structured to meet the needs of the business world.

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In 2024, Corporate Trainings Provided on Earthquake and Disaster Awareness



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BÜYEM Corporate Social Responsibility and EU & ISTKA Projects



The main purpose of Boğaziçi University Lifelong Learning Centre (BÜYEM)'s Corporate Social Responsibility Projects and EU & ISTKA Projects carried out in partnership with the European Union and Istanbul Development Agency is to contribute to social development and increase the capacity of individuals and communities in areas such as education, social awareness and employment. While social responsibility projects support social equality by providing education and awareness to disadvantaged groups, EU & ISTKA Projects aim to produce concrete solutions on issues such as economic and social development, entrepreneurship and vocational training through local and international cooperation. With these projects, educational opportunities are offered to different segments of society and social benefit-oriented initiatives are supported.

Some examples of BÜYEM's Corporate Social Responsibility Projects:

- My Knowledge My Abundance: Inclusive Growth Association, seminars on financial literacy and good agricultural practices were organised for farmers with the contributions of Izmir Commodity Exchange and Izmir Provincial Directorate of Agriculture.
- My Future is Tourism: In cooperation with Anadolu Efes, sustainable tourism strategies were developed in a total of 27 implementation areas in 22 provinces and 5 districts to support the social and economic development of regions with tourism potential, and 3355 people were recruited to the tourism sector.
- Beauty Expertise Training: In cooperation with L'Oréal, women between the ages of 18-28, who are unemployed and suffering from financial difficulties, were provided with beautician training within the framework of a certificate programme, enabling them to have a profession.

Some examples of EU & ISTKA Projects:

Opening Amasya to New Markets Project: Considering the need for Amasya to open up to new markets; trainings were provided on foreign trade, electronics, business development, basic English, business English and computer skills.



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- Entrepreneurship Project in Beyoğlu: In the project prepared upon the request of Beyoğlu Municipality; trainings were given on making wooden toys and accessories, information-archiving, and setting up e-business over the internet.

Lifelong Learning Access Policy

According to Boğaziçi University's Code of Ethics, '2 - To act fairly and honestly without discrimination and prejudice based on religion, language, race, ethnic origin, opinion, gender, sexual orientation, age, physical disability and similar characteristics, 4 - To protect the freedom of information, knowledge, learning and teaching'. In addition, Boğaziçi University has a Gender Equality Commission and a Gender Equality Plan against discrimination against women. Students with disabilities are provided with an accessible academic and social environment where they are not discriminated against, and have the opportunity to receive individual support from the Disabled Student Unit and GETEM (Technology and Education Laboratory for the Visually Impaired). Boğaziçi University Lifelong Learning Centre (BÜYEM), Corporate Social Responsibility Projects and EU & İSTKA Projects carry out activities open to various social groups with the aim of inclusiveness and reaching large masses. In addition, projects such as the Young Immigrant Entrepreneurs Project and My Sister Project organise special trainings for immigrants, women or the development of different social groups.

GETEM can be used in the Manage Libraries section of the Easy Reader application, which you can download for free to your iOS, Android and Windows devices.

To help our users, a general video with Easy Reader usage tips and a special guide video for Android devices are also available. TEKNOFEST: Technology Competitions Engaging Society

Organized annually under the leadership of the Ministry of Industry and Technology of Türkiye and in partnership with numerous institutions, TEKNOFEST is the world's largest aviation, space, and technology festival. Its mission is to foster public interest in technology and advance Türkiye's transformation into a society that produces and develops technology. Since the festival's inception in 2018, Boğaziçi University has been an active partner, contributing to an event that features technology competitions, air shows, concerts, talks, and a wide range of activities.

At TEKNOFEST 2024, technology competitions were held across 46 main categories and 117 subcategories, including Rocket, Model Satellite, Artificial Intelligence in Healthcare, Biotechnology Innovation, Digital Technologies in Industry, Flying Car Simulation, Educational Technologies, Autonomous Passenger Vehicle (Robotaxi), Agricultural Technologies, Combat UAVs, and Chip Design. New competitions introduced in 2024 included Wireless Communication, Blockchain, Air Defense Systems, Financial Technologies, Unmanned Marine Vehicles, Smart Wi-Fi Coverage, and TEKNOFEST Robolig.

Students were actively encouraged to participate in these competitions, presenting their projects at festival stands to thousands of science and technology enthusiasts. Such initiatives not only extend beyond the boundaries of the university campus but also create a learning environment where the knowledge and skills of Boğaziçi University's community are shared with society—strengthening public engagement, outreach, and knowledge transfer.



TULAP: An Open Research and Learning Platform for Turkish Natural Language Processing

Developed by faculty members at Boğaziçi University, the Turkish Natural Language Processing Platform (TULAP) provides an open-access resource for researchers and learners beyond the university. Designed to address the shortage of Turkish-specific datasets and software tools in the field of natural language processing (NLP), the platform was created under the leadership of Prof. Dr. Tunga Güngör and Dr. Suzan Üsküdarlı from the Department of Computer Engineering, with contributions from Assoc. Prof. Dr. Arzucan Özgür of the same department and Prof. Dr. Balkız Öztürk Başaran from the Department of Linguistics.

TULAP allows users to experiment with tools via a demo interface and integrate them into their own systems through Docker-based commands, thereby encouraging the participation of individuals outside academia in high-quality research and learning processes. In this respect, TULAP stands as a concrete example of Boğaziçi University's mission to produce digital educational resources for the public good and to contribute to lifelong learning.

Youth For Future Talks: Digital Content Creation and Media Literacy Series

Boğaziçi University hosts the “Youth For Future Talks” series to encourage youth participation and promote a culture of lifelong learning. Organized in collaboration with Boğaziçi University Social Media Lab, TEM Agency, and the social enterprise Askıda Ne Var, the series aims to enhance young people’s knowledge and awareness of media literacy, content creation, and digital communication.

The first event, “Youth For Future Talks Vol. #1,” was held on March 22, 2024, at Albert Long Hall, bringing together around 400 students from 27 universities in Istanbul. The program featured social media content creator Berk Keklik (Uberkuloz) as guest speaker, alongside presentations by Prof. Dr. Aslıhan Nasır, Director of the Information Systems Research and Application Center (ISRC), and Prof. Dr. Hande Türker, Deputy Director, who shared insights into the center’s work. Serhat Demir, General Manager of TEM Agency, also delivered a talk on content marketing. As part of the event, three students were awarded annual scholarships, while ten students received one-time bursaries.

The second event, held on May 10, 2024, focused on “Effective Content Development in Social Media” and featured digital content creators Ali Abdüsselam Yılmaz (“Deli Mi Ne?”) and Mehtap Algül, alongside Temuçin Ünalp, Founder of TEM Agency, and Aykut Çetinkaya, Group Director. In recognition of their contributions, education bursaries totaling 10,000 TL were provided to university students.

Looking ahead, the series will continue with open workshops and training programs designed for young audiences. This initiative stands as a concrete example of Boğaziçi University’s institutional commitment to community-based learning and youth empowerment.

Established under a cooperation protocol signed between Boğaziçi University and Kaspersky, the Istanbul Transparency Center has begun operating as a new hub for professional training in the field of cybersecurity. Serving as a transparency facility, the Center enables the company's partners, clients, and regulatory authorities in the cybersecurity field to review the source code of all Kaspersky products, software updates, and threat detection rules.

Within the Center, a Transparency Laboratory has also been set up to deliver hands-on training seminars to students both onsite and online. The lab focuses on methodologies and techniques for evaluating the quality of supply chain solutions and detecting cyber threats. Developed with the support of Boğaziçi University's Technology Transfer Office, this joint initiative aims to enhance the sectoral competencies of young talents, foster new ventures in Turkey's cybersecurity ecosystem, and strengthen the University's commitment to providing professional education accessible to the wider society.

Supported by leading industry partners including Kaspersky, THY Turkish Technology, Turkcell, and top national cybersecurity firms, the camp equipped participants with high-level professional competencies while fostering direct networking opportunities with industry experts. In addition, the “Women in Technology” panel highlighted the critical role of women in cybersecurity and promoted gender equality and inclusion in the tech sector.

Educational Cooperation between Boğaziçi University and YETEV

Boğaziçi University continues to advance innovative teaching and learning opportunities beyond the campus, sharing cutting-edge educational approaches with society. As a key step in this vision, the University has signed a “Montessori Teacher Training Practices and Educational Cooperation Protocol” with the Yeni Türkiye Eğitim Vakfı (YETEV).

Through this collaboration, Boğaziçi University’s academic expertise will be combined with YETEV’s field-based implementation experience to deliver teacher training programs aimed at disseminating the scientifically grounded and culturally responsive principles of Montessori pedagogy. The protocol is designed to:

- Provide teacher candidates with internationally recognized Montessori certification,
- Enable faculty members in the Faculty of Education to observe field practices and translate them into academic research, and
- Promote pedagogical innovation at preschool and primary levels through creative initiatives such as Philosophy for Children symposia.

This joint initiative strengthens Boğaziçi University’s community-focused educational outreach and impact on sustainable development by sharing inclusive, lifelong learning models from early childhood to primary education through university–foundation collaboration.

Boğaziçi Lectures: A Public Learning Platform Bringing the History of Science to Society

Through its Boğaziçi Lectures series, Boğaziçi University provides free, open-access opportunities for scientific learning to a broad audience beyond the campus, thereby fostering lifelong education. At the most recent event, held on 15 November 2024, Prof. Dr. F. Jamil Ragep—former Director of the Canada Research Chair in the History of Science in Islamic Societies at McGill University—delivered a comprehensive lecture on the history of astronomy and conceptions of the cosmos, spanning Ancient Greece, Islamic philosophers, and pre-modern European thinkers.

In his talk, Prof. Dr. Ragep underscored how Islamic scholars' precise mathematical calculations of the Earth's circumference—supported by sophisticated observational methods—remarkably align with today's measurements. He also highlighted the historical importance of astronomical instruments developed in centers such as Istanbul, Samarkand, Azerbaijan, and Delhi, and noted how Qur'anic verses on the cosmos inspired Islamic philosophers to pursue scientific observation and inquiry.

By hosting globally recognized scholars, intellectuals, and policymakers in fields such as science, culture, the arts, literature, and international relations, Boğaziçi Lectures strengthens the public sharing of knowledge and serves as a leading example of expanding inclusive, lifelong learning opportunities in line with the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

Inclusive Education and Social Participation through “Voicing Books”

Through the “Voicing Books” initiative—developed in collaboration with the Visually Impaired Technology and Education Laboratory (GETEM) and launched as part of Türk Telekom’s “Accessible Theatre” project—Boğaziçi University is creating a volunteer-driven network for education and cultural sharing that makes knowledge and literature more accessible to visually impaired individuals.

With this application, volunteers record and upload audiobooks via their mobile devices, leading the way in expanding accessible cultural resources across society. Earthquake Awareness Training in Collaboration with Beykoz Municipality

Through its Mobile Earthquake Simulation Education Truck (GEDSET), Boğaziçi University's Kandilli Observatory and Earthquake Research Institute (KOERI) extends earthquake awareness and disaster preparedness to all segments of society. On 25 June 2025, in collaboration with the Beykoz Municipality, KOERI hosted a public outreach event at Küçüksu Recreation Area, where the GEDSET truck provided practical training on pre-earthquake preparation, appropriate behavior during seismic events, and post-earthquake safety measures. Participants experienced a 20-second earthquake simulation inside the truck, turning theoretical knowledge into real-life practice. By engaging local communities in direct, experiential learning, this initiative strengthens Boğaziçi University's mission of public education and disaster risk reduction. Building on similar programs with other municipalities, the university has now added Beykoz to its network of collaborations, expanding earthquake awareness well beyond campus boundaries.

Public Days at Boğaziçi University's Kandilli Observatory

On 18–20 August 2025, to mark the 26th anniversary of the 17 August 1999 Marmara Earthquake, Boğaziçi University's Kandilli Observatory and Earthquake Research Institute (KOERI) hosted "Public Days," an exemplary lifelong learning initiative that brought science directly to the wider community.

Held at the Üsküdar-based Kandilli Campus and open to all citizens, the three-day program invited visitors to explore ongoing scientific work first-hand, ranging from earthquake and tsunami research to astronomy. Critical facilities—including the Regional Earthquake-Tsunami Monitoring Center, Historical Science Collections, Deprempark, and the Astronomy Laboratory—were opened for public tours and interactive engagement.

This outreach event enabled people from diverse backgrounds to meet scientists face-to-face and experience current research in action. By offering free, open-access educational opportunities that extend beyond the academic sphere, Boğaziçi University strengthened public awareness of disaster preparedness and natural phenomena, reaffirming its commitment to lifelong learning and science communication for societal resilience.
