

Publication Requirement for Graduation from Master's Programs in Science and Engineering:

Provided that it is derived from the student's master's thesis, at least one of the following publication conditions must be satisfied:*

1. An article published, accepted for publication, or submitted for publication in a journal indexed by SCIE/SSCI/AHCI/Scopus.**
2. A paper presented, or accepted for presentation, at an international*** conference and published, or accepted for publication, in full paper**** within the conference proceedings.
3. A granted or pending national/international patent, utility model, or industrial design.
4. A book, or book chapter, published, accepted for publication, or submitted for publication by an international publishing house.
 - Boğaziçi University must be designated as the institutional affiliation of both the student and the advisor in any publication derived from the thesis. Should the thesis research be conducted partially at the student's employing institution, said institution may be indicated as a secondary affiliation.
 - The departmental chairperson must approve the eligibility of the outputs regarding the graduation requirement.
 - Even in the event of a successful thesis defense, the relevant institute shall not approve graduation unless the publication requirement is fulfilled.

* This requirement shall enter into force on 01.09.2026.

** For an article submitted for publication, the corresponding author must be the advisor.

*** Internationally announced conferences wherein presentations are delivered in English.

**** In instances where the publication of full-text proceedings is not customary for conferences pertinent to the respective department, a paper published as an abstract within the conference proceedings may be accepted, subject to the affirmative opinion of the departmental chairperson.

Departments reserve the right to establish supplementary conditions, contingent upon the approval of the respective institute board.
