Position of English glosses/ Usage of *italics* and/or **bold**

To accommodate a request from the Linguistics department, English glosses of sentences or phrases used as examples from languages other than English need not be presented in footnotes. As is the convention in Linguistics papers, such glosses will appear in the text, immediately under the original---language utterance. In the case of longer ones, these may be presented as an indented block quote, single--spaced.

Linguistics students can prefer to use *italics* and/or **bold** for data with the knowledge of their advisors.
